

The PTO meeting on Oct 11 was postponed until October 18. The meeting was called to order at 6:08pm by President Joanne Polfus who led us in the pledge of allegiance. All officers were present.

Our previous business included Laura attending the Santa Secret Shop open house. We were asked if we could switch our sale dates. We decided to host the Shop on December 14-15, 2016. Sign up sheets for volunteers will be created at the next meeting. Ideas of a vendor craft show were discussed. Shirley Johnson suggests October 2017. We will review the calendar and pick a date at the next meeting. Joanne will ask Shirley for her opinion on a good date. Our Carney-Nadeau apparel is almost ready to order. And the students are participating in the 3 point t-shirt design contest. Joanne wants to post a large desk top calendar in the concession stand so we can see who is working and where we need more volunteers. We decided to start selling Debacker's chocolate milk November 28 as we will have several games a week from then on. We also discussed ways to fund drinking fountain replacements with the water bottle filling kind. They are quite expensive-over \$1000 each. Dana Dziezdic was planning to look into it too so Laura will contact her. Finally we want to consolidate our PTO accounts into one and we think the best time to do that will be at the end of the school year when the fiscal year ends.

In New Business we gave the addresses from last years 3 point shirt sponsors to Laura to type up so we can mail them out. We also discussed ideas for a PTO fundraiser. Our favorite is a haunted hayride idea but to do it in the spring and come up with a cool name. We also discussed hosting a Senior all night party but most seniors have party's that same day and graduation is on a Sat afternoon so it makes it hard to plan a lock-in of sorts. Cow Pie Bingo was brought up as a way to fund the party. And finally with Parent-Teacher Conferences coming up we thought we should have soups and rolls and crackers available for the teachers and staff that evening, November 10. All agreed to bring something.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:36pm by Laura and seconded by Joanne. Out next PTO meeting will be held November 7 at 3:30pm.
