As first stated this past Friday, Carney-Nadeau Public School will be providing free grab-and-go breakfasts and lunches for all students during the mandated time of school closure, which begins on Monday, March 16th and extends through Sunday, April 5. This now includes two meals per day for each child on the weekends. Meals are available for either pick-up here at the school or, if your circumstances require it, for home delivery.

Below are the dates on which meals will be available for pick-up and delivery: Again, we have a large food order being delivered on Tuesday, March 17th which is why the schedule for the upcoming week is a bit different than for the other two.

Monday, March 16th: All students signed up are eligible to receive one grab-and-go breakfast and lunch. Meals will be available for pick-up here at the school at 10:00 am and home delivery of meals will start around this time as well.

Tuesday, March 17th: All students signed up are eligible to receive six grab-and-go breakfasts and lunches. Meals will be available for pick-up here at the school at 11:00 am and home delivery of meals will start around this time as well.

Monday, March 23rd and Monday, March 30th: All students signed up are eligible to receive seven grab-and-go breakfasts and lunches. Meals will be available for pick-up here at the school at 10:00 am and home delivery of meals will start around this time as well.

Please come to our main entrance for meal pick-up.

This same information will be sent via mass call-out notification later today so those without internet access will be made aware of this service. Those without home internet access may phone in their meal orders by calling 906-639-2171. Anyone with internet access is strongly encouraged to use the survey above, as this will allow us to more efficiently fill orders.
