## **Mission Statement**

## **Purpose**

## **Strategies & Activities**

- Annual Open House
- Provide student's individual assessment result, DiBels Next results, MEAP/MME results, progress reports, and report cards.
- Flexible scheduled parent/teacher conferences twice a year.
- A description and explanation of the curriculum in use at the school, the form of assessment used to measure student progress and the proficiency levels students are expected to meet.
- MiBlisi Expectations (elementary wide discipline plan)
- Publish school newsletter and or Daily Announcements on the CNPS Website informing parents about the parent involvement plan and other events at the school. This newsletter will also send a positive invitation to

parents to participate in various activities while providing parents information at a glance about scheduled school meetings and activities.

- School-Parent Compact that outlines how parents and school staff will share the responsibility for improved student achievement of their student.
- Maintain a consistent effort to communicate regularly with parents via phone calls, emails, and or CNPS Facebook page.
- Invite parents to serve as chaperones, volunteers for Booster Club, and or to assist within the classrooms for certain projects or specials.

### **Relations with Parents**

CNPS needs parents to assume and exercise responsibility for their student's behavior. During school hours, the school, through its designated administrators, recognizes the responsibility to monitor student's behavior and as with academic matters, the importance of cooperation between the school and the parents in the matters relating to conduct.

For the benefit of the student, the school encourages parents to support their student's career in school by:

- Maintaining an active interest in their student's daily work, monitoring and making it possible for him/her to complete assigned homework by providing a quiet place and suitable conditions for study.
