- A. <u>NMCCS Update w/Josh Sampson</u> Josh was not in attendance. NMCCS has gained about 10 students & the jail location in Escanaba is running smoothly.
- B. <u>PTO/Booster Club Update w/Joanne Polfus</u> The PTO will be purchasing a hand washing station for the Concession Stand. A health inspection report noted that the hand washing station was required and all open food containers must have a date stamp on them.
- C. <u>Giving Tree</u> All the Giving Tree tags have been taken. We reduced the number of eligible students this year to ensure that all those would be able to receive Christmas Gifts.
- D. School Evacuation Drill We recently had a practice evacuation drill, it went very well.
- E. <u>School Improvement Bond Update</u> After looking at our current mound system, it was determined that an additional building can be tied into the current septic system. There is a 50 foot variance for building near the mound system. There is also a telephone line that runs between the mound system and our current building.
- F. <u>Grant Chandler Proposal</u> Grant proposed a \$22K annual fee to continue our Blue Print Services. We aren't able to pay that amount, Grant may offer his services for free this year.
