- B. After School Tutoring Update – Our first session started 11-9-21. We currently have 38 students signed up; everything is going well.
- C. ESSER III Funds – 20% of funds must be spent on lost learning initiatives, would also like to purchase a bus, cover PowerSchool fees, technology purchases, after school programming.
- D. Bus Maintenance – May need to find a different source for bus repairs, BRH is very busy.
- E. School Nurse – MC-ISD received a grant for school nurses. Each school in the county will have a nurse one-day per week for the remainder of the school year.
- F. Stage Pads – We are still looking at safety pads for around the front of the stage and the columns on each side of it.
