- A. <u>Mid-Year Test Data</u> NWEA Testing, PSAT practice testing, will see gains by working on the categories that students struggled in.
- B. <u>Girls' Softball</u> Scuderi & Johnson working on organizing a girls' club softball team, 23 girls are signed up, will need about \$5,000 in sponsorship the 1<sup>st</sup> year to get up and rolling.
- C. <u>Projects Update</u>—HS Tech Lab raised flooring section is complete. Will work on Bus Garage door trim and trophy cases. Purchased maple that is being kiln dried and planed.
- D. <u>School Breakfast Expansion Grant</u> Received \$9,714 to purchase a new freezer, toaster and rethermalizer.
- E. <u>School Security Grant</u> \$31,731 to possibly purchase new cameras, PA System, additional bus radio/camera, radio in van, possible walkie talkies for playground. Security Assessment in April to determine what is needed.
- F. <u>Buses/Drivers Update</u> 2<sup>nd</sup> new bus to arrive Monday. Dennis will not return as bus driver. Michele Davis is sub driving. Will post for open bus route driver position.
- G. <u>English Teacher 2023-2024</u> Sarah Jackson will not return for the 23-24 school year. She is going back to college to work on a master's degree. Will post this position.
- H. <u>Governor's 2023-2024 Budget Proposal</u> Budget is a long time away from finalization. Possible 5% foundation allowance increase
- I. <u>Math Configuration Update</u> Split Classes with Scuderi and P. Polfus are going well. They are able to help failing students get passing grades.
- J. <u>School Dog</u> –Would like to see a therapy dog sharing time between Elem SE & HS SE. Adam will research all the aspects, wants to talk to trainers and will contact Thrun, SET SEG & NEOLA.
