- B. <u>New REP Report Requirements</u> New changes to REP Report require all employee changes to be recorded in REP monthly rather than twice a year.
- C. <u>New Grants</u> New School Security Grant,23G back on Track state is guaranteed to grant a fixed amount for all M-Step test scores that are below a certain threshold.
- D. Redistribution of Existing Superintendent Salary to Better Reflect Transportation Supervisor Role The State is going to be setting aside a portion of funding for Transportation for each school. They are setting up a 4-tier funding system.
- E. <u>English Units 10-12</u> Supplemental Socioemotional units Mr. Cocco is exposing students to as many jobs/careers as possible. Each student will pick their top career choice and do a project on that job/career.
