VIII. Discussion Items:

- A. "Band" App for Sports Team Scheduling, Communications – Free App for notifications/communications for practices, game changes, etc. Will try the App for Track, Golf and Softball this year.
- B. Michigan's Proposed Educational Spending Budget for 2026-2027 – Increases possible for Transportation funding, per pupil, SE, At-Risk and dual enrollment. Reduced allowance for online schools? Taking additional 528 million to fund public colleges.
- C. Spring Pupil Accounting Update/Transportation Audit – Mr. Cocco & Jen Wagner have been working on pupil accounting. Jen has it completed and Steve Martin will audit.
- D. Spring Standardized Testing Update – We are in good shape; all test sessions have been scheduled. Testing tickets and training are done. Parent Letter #2 will be sent out, testing to start after spring break.
- E. Operating Millage Restoration – The November Election option is still on the table. CNPS received the lowest State Funding of all the schools in the U.P. due to our low millage amount due to our Millage Restoration Proposal rejection. Since we are under the 18%, we didn't receive the minimum per pupil funding amount.

 - C. Moved by M. Corrigan and supported by Jackson to approve the Hire of Ms. Madison Eichhorn as Long-Term Sub for Elem/JH/HS Band/Music, a shared position w/North Central, for a period beginning March 2, 2026 and ending May 29, 2026. Voice Vote: 5-0, All Ayes.
- X. Public Comment: Ed J. – 18 mills restores the minimum funding, what will the additional monies be used for? A new boiler, yes, but money toward a new bus or roof wouldn't fly.
